

RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
November 8, 2007

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: Susan Carter, Presiding Commissioner and Doug Galaske, Eastern District Commissioner, and Randy Asbury, Western District Commissioner. Com. Carter recorded the minutes in the absence of Deputy Clerk Nancy Copenhaver.

9:10 a.m., Com. Carter called the meeting to order. Com. Carter moved, Com. Galaske seconded approval of the agenda; motion carried (3-0).

9:15 a.m., Tony DeLong of the University of Missouri Extension stopped in to update the Commission on his progress regarding the strategic planning project for the County.

10:10 a.m., Randolph County citizen Carol Hills came by seeking information on procedures for establishing private cemeteries in the County. Com. Carter will research it and get back to her.

10:20 a.m., Commissioners reviewed invoices presented for payment. Com. Galaske moved, Com. Asbury seconded approval of the invoices; motion carried (3-0).

Checks 5948-6005 were signed for payment of approved invoices for the following funds: General Revenue \$23,185.08; LE Trng. \$56.27; Assmt. \$370.82; Road & Bridge \$304,948.71; Election Service \$41.00; E911 \$443.63 and JC \$20,674.28. Total amount of checks: \$349,719.79.

10:45 a.m., Commissioners reviewed and handled correspondence.

11:30 a.m., Com. Galaske moved, Com. Asbury seconded approval of the minutes of November 6 with changes; motion carried (3-0).

11:45 a.m., Commissioners discussed Sheriff Nichols' plan to increase deputy patrols throughout the County for the next two weekends to discourage poaching during deer season.

11:50 a.m., Com. Carter moved, Com. Asbury seconded approval of the purchase of "no parking" signs for the Moberly Courthouse parking lot in the amount of \$63.50; motion carried (3-0) and Road and Bridge Supervisor Bill Dougherty was instructed to order the signs.


12:00 p.m., the Commission recessed for lunch.
