

**RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES**  
**July 17, 2008**

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: Susan Carter, Presiding Commissioner, Doug Galaske, Eastern District Commissioner, Randy Asbury, Western District Commissioner and Deputy Clerk, Janet Pierard.

**9:15 a.m.** Com. Carter called the meeting to order. Com. Carter moved the approval of the agenda. Com. Asbury seconded approval of the agenda, motion carried (3-0).

**9:20 a.m.** Com. Asbury moved approval of the minutes with corrections for 07-10-08. Com. Galaske seconded, motion carried (3-0). Bill Dougherty, Road and Bridge Supervisor, came in with the maintenance reports and discussed various road issues. Com. Carter moved approval of the minutes with corrections for 07-15-08, Com. Galaske seconded, motion carried (3-0).

**9:30 a.m.** Joan Joseph, 911 Coordinator, Cliff Miller and Larry White, Special Road District, arrived to discuss reassigning CR2362, a private road number to be determined. This is due to a mapping error.

**10:00 a.m.** Com. Galaske moved approval of the invoices as presented, Com. Asbury seconded, motion carried (3-0) and checks were signed. Commission handled correspondence. Checks 9025-9062 were signed for payment of approved invoices for the following funds: General Revenue \$10,359.69; PA Trng. \$80.00; Assmt. \$3,351.39; Road & Bridge \$20,771.06; Elec Service \$357.00 and JC \$4,037.33. Total amount of checks: \$46,708.47

**10:10 a.m.** Com. Asbury reported an email sent to Sheriff Mark Nichols on 07-16-08 asking him to notify Securix of the 07-31-08 deadline for inmate phone service for proposal. Sheriff Nichols responded that they will be forwarding a proposal as soon as possible.

**10:20 a.m.** Bill Dougherty, Road and Bridge Supervisor, called to report speaking with Jerry Quigley, Jacksonville Veterans Cemetery Director, regarding putting a pipe and dirt in the ditch at the Jacksonville Cemetery Road to prevent erosion. Commission approved.

**10:30 a.m.** Com. Galaske called Linda Kempker regarding to a previous complaint on CR2210. She was told that the rock has been changed from 1" to 1½" rock to provide a better road base.

**10:40 a.m.** Robert Dennis called to complain about the gravel on CR1355.

**10:50 a.m.** Janet Murray, Randolph County Health Department, and Realator Dennis McKeown, arrived to discuss upgrading the county lagoon ordinance. There was a proposal to require inspections and upgrades of existing properties prior to or at the time of sale.

**12:25 p.m.** Meeting reconvened.

**12:45 p.m.** Com. Carter called Rick Howard, Maintenance Supervisor, regarding janitorial and maintenance issues at the Justice Center and the Moberly Courthouse.

**1:00 p.m.** Com. Carter called Matt Everts, City of Moberly, stating the commission will be approving the culvert application as long as it is on only the city's property.

**1:10 p.m.** Debbie Turner called in with a complaint on the 1½" rock on CR 1725.


**1:50 p.m.** Commissioners left to attend a 911 Joint Commission meeting at the Randolph County Ambulance District office.
