2:20 p.m., Commissioners returned a call to Ben Herrold, Moberly Monitor Index, for the weekly news conference.


3:00 p.m., Corey Mehaffy and David Gaines, Moberly Area Economic Development Corporation, arrived to update the Commission on recent projects.
