

RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES

Tuesday, March 22, 2011

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: Susan Carter, Presiding Commissioner; Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner, Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner, and Tara McPherson, Deputy Clerk.

9:00 a.m. Com. Carter called the meeting to order and moved approval of the agenda with one addition. Dan Niec, MoDot, will be arriving at 10:00 to discuss the repair of the Kansas City Southern's railroad bridge. Com. Crutchfield seconded and the motion passed (3-0).

Commissioner reported on their attendance last Thursday at the Northeast Missouri Commissioners and Clerks Association Spring Conference in Palmyra. Randolph County will host the 2012 conference in Moberly. Com. Carter was elected Vice-chair of the association for 2011-2012.

Com. Wilcox reported on a concerned citizen who came to his residence Sunday afternoon to report on a culvert cave in on CR 2520. Com. Wilcox contacted Road and Bridge Supervisor Mike Rogers and the area was marked for repair.

Commissioners reviewed and signed a Request for Funds form in the amount of \$2,625 for engineering services for the North Sugar Creek Township CDBG bridge project which will be forwarded to Robin Fitzgerald, MTRCOG, for payment.

9:50 a.m. Charla Bankhead, of Higbee, Mr. and Mrs. Bill Dameron, and Kay Daniels arrived to observe the 10 o'clock meeting concerning the condemned CR 2580 Kansas City Southern railroad bridge..

Ron Watts, MoDot District Liaison, and Dan Niec, MoDot District Engineer, arrived for their meeting concerning the Kansas City Southern's railroad bridges on CR 2561 and CR 2580. Mr. Niec informed the Commission that he spoke with the Higbee City Council and reported that after leaving the council meeting a group of Higbee citizens expressed interest in reopening the bridge on CR 2561.

11:00 a.m. The weekly fuel bid was awarded to Wright's Oil and Propane Inc. at 3.205. Brownfield Oil bid at 3.238 and MFA Oil bid at 3.24.

11:30 a.m. Road and Bridge Supervisor Mike Rogers arrived to deliver the specifications for purchase of new trucks and equipment for the county Road and Bridge crew. They discussed the issue of a proper vehicle for Rick Howard, Maintenance, to drive. Mr. Rogers also asked the Commission about whether or not CR 1280 is still maintained by the county. Com. Wilcox informed him that it is.

12:30 p.m. Commissioners reviewed invoices for payment. Com. Wilcox called Road and Bridge Supervisor Mike Rogers to confirm January fuel deliveries. Com. Wilcox made a motion to approve invoices as presented. Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (3-0) and checks were signed.

12:45 p.m. Jeff Schulte, Superior Business Solutions, arrived to discuss an alternate way to post the weekly agendas and minutes through a new software program. Further discussion will be held.

Commissioners reviewed correspondence. Commissioners received an invitation to attend Randolph County Government Day at the American Legion Wednesday March 23rd at noon. Com. Wilcox will attend.

Commissioners received an invitation to attend Randolph County Farm Bureau annual legislative banquet Thursday evening March 24th. Com. Wilcox and Com. Crutchfield will attend.


1:15 p.m. Steve Barnes arrived to discuss closure of the CR 2580 Kansas City Southern railroad bridge and possible solutions to reopening it.


