

**RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES**  
**Thursday, April 7, 2011**

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: Susan Carter, Presiding Commissioner; Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner, Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner, and Tara McPherson, Deputy Clerk.

**9:00 a.m.** Com. Carter called the meeting to order and moved approval of the agenda. Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (3-0).

Rick Howard, Maintenance, arrived to deliver bids from Soloman Boiler Works for boilers maintenance at the Huntsville and Moberly Courthouses. Additionally discussion was held on: repair of a security camera at the Justice Center, replacement of the back door at the Huntsville Courthouse, and the need to contact Fred Malicott regarding the proper size of compressor hoses at the Justice Center.

**10:00 a.m.** Following review, Com. Wilcox moved approval of invoices for payment as presented. Com. Crutchfield seconded, motion passed (3-0), and checks were signed. County Clerk Will Ellis arrived delivering reports from Commerce Bank and Judge Cynthia Suter. Clerk Ellis also reported on the success of election operations. Glen Parks, Moberly Motors, arrived to deliver a truck bid.

Janet Murray, Randolph County Health Department, arrived to visit with the Commission.

Com. Carter received a call from NECAC regarding a request for a proclamation declaring National Community Action month.

Commissioners received a call from Darrell Reeves, CR2788, saying there was a need for dust control on CR 2788. Com. Carter informed Mr. Reeves that there will be discussion with the Road and Bridge crew and the Commission will get back to him.

**11:15 a.m.** Com. Carter recessed the meeting for a luncheon with the Road and Bridge crew.

**2:00 p.m.** Com. Carter reconvened the meeting.

Commissioners received a comment from Bob Martin, CR 1920 and Highway J. Mr. Martin said that there was a ditching and gravel washing problem. He was informed that it would be brought to the attention of Road and Bridge Supervisor Mike Rogers.

Com. Crutchfield reported on a visit with Frank Lyon about CR 1735 and Mr. Lyon agreed to purchase a culvert and have the county rework the road.

**3:20 p.m.** Commissioner reviewed the Wiley Ferguson Living Memorial Scholarship and made their selection which will be announced at a later date.


County Clerk Will Ellis arrived to discuss that the county would no longer deduct supplemental insurance premiums from employee's paychecks.




