

RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
Thursday, May 5, 2011

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: Presiding Commissioner Susan Carter; Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner; Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner; and Tara McPherson, Deputy Clerk.

9:00 a.m. Com. Carter called the meeting to order and moved approval of the agenda with one addition: FEMA Representative Rick Butler will be arriving at 2:30 p.m. for a follow up meeting which had been originally scheduled for Tuesday, May 10, 2011.

Com. Crutchfield reported on his attendance at a MoDOT local planning meeting for right of way processes and land acquisition on Wednesday May 4, 2011 at the MoDOT facility in Macon, MO. Commissioners returned a call to Representative Randy Asbury who inquired about their thoughts on the proposed MoDOT redistricting plan.

County Clerk Will Ellis arrived to report that he discussed FEMA reports with a SEMA Representative who told Clerk Ellis that FEMA would need information on equipment use, over-time, other resources used, and volunteers involved.

Following review Com. Wilcox made a motion to approve invoices for payment as presented. Com. Crutchfield seconded, motion passed (3-0) and checks were signed.

Circuit Clerk Peggy Boots stopped by and discussed the possibility of a storage facility for her records.

11:35 a.m. Com. Crutchfield left the meeting to attend the Moberly Rotary Club.

11:45 a.m. Com. Carter recessed the meeting so she and Com. Wilcox could attend National Day of Prayer at Moberly City Hall.

1:20 p.m. Com. Carter reconvened the meeting.

1:45 p.m. Joan Joseph, 9-1-1 Coordinator, arrived to report on a revised mileage count for the Randolph County roads. A recalculation, based on the Road Centerline Summary report, indicated Randolph County has 477.6 miles and Moberly Special Road District has 90.3 miles. Mrs. Joseph also requested a letter from the Commission confirming that monies collected for driveway permits are to be deposited in the 9-1-1 fund.

2:20 p.m. Rick Butler, FEMA Representative, arrived for the follow up meeting where the county provided detailed documentation that FEMA needed for Randolph County's claim in regards to the disaster declaration (1961).

Commissioners received a call from Macon County Presiding Commissioner Alan Wyatt inviting them to a meeting on Monday, May 9, 2011 at 1:00 p.m. at the Macon Expo Center to discuss planned closing of MoDOT's Macon office.


Commissioners decided that during the week of June 20th, 2011 they would hold public hearings at various locations throughout the county to hear citizen's concerns.
