

RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES

Tuesday, May 24, 2011

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner; Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner acting as Presiding Commissioner in Commissioner Carter's absence; and Tara McPherson, Deputy Clerk.

9:10 a.m. Com. Crutchfield called the meeting to order and moved approval of the agenda, second by Com. Wilcox. Motion passed (2-0).

Com. Wilcox reported on receiving a phone call from Mrs. Ray Richardson, CR 1010, regarding a complaint on this road. Mrs. Richardson's complaint was referred to Road and Bridge Supervisor Mike Rogers.

The Commission received a call from Don Schwartz, MoDOT Safety Division, regarding bridges on CR 2561 and CR 2580.

Assessor Richard Tregnago arrived to inform the Commission that the flood lights on the back of the Huntsville Courthouse need to be adjusted and to discuss proposed 2011 Board of Equalization meeting dates.

9:45 a.m. Rick Howard, Maintenance, arrived to discuss air conditioning proposals for the Moberly Courthouse, Huntsville Courthouse and moving of AC units at the Justice Center.

Laura Snelling, Chariton Valley, called regarding problems with Coroner Gerald Luntsford's cell phone reception.

10:00 a.m. Circuit Clerk Peggy Boots arrived to discuss specifications for the proposed storage facility.

Com. Carter arrived to the meeting and reported on a conversation with Prosecuting Attorney Mike Fusselman Friday concerning the VOCA Grant. He has begun filing this grant electronically and will no longer need the Presiding Commissioner's signature.

County Clerk Will Ellis arrived to discuss the employment agreement with Road and Bridge Supervisor.

Commissioners signed official minutes from May 10, 2011, May 12, 2011, and May 17, 2011.

Commissioners reviewed correspondence.

Cleaning Specialist Randy Walder, Meyer Laboratory Inc., stopped by to discuss the county's industrial cleaning and maintenance products needs. He was referred to the Jail and Maintenance Supervisors.

12:00 p.m. Following review, Com. Wilcox made a motion to approve invoices for payment as presented. Com. Crutchfield seconded, motion passed (3-0) and checks were signed.

County Clerk Will Ellis and employees in the Clerk's office have volunteered to collect donated items and transport them to Moberly for assistance to the victims of the Joplin tornado.

1:00 p.m. Road and Bridge Supervisor Mike Rogers arrived to discuss road maintenance updates. Discussion was held about the road issues on CR 1010 and CR 2010 and Mr. Rogers agreed to address these issues.

Brenda Ward, Secretary of Northeast Fire Protection District, called confirming the availability of the fire station at Levicks Mill for the county wide meeting, scheduled for June 22, 2011, where citizens can speak with the Commission

Com. Wilcox contacted Mark Hibbs to confirm Clark City Hall as a location for one of the county-wide meeting places where citizens can speak with Commissioners

Commissioners received an invitation from Northeast Community Action Corporation (NECAC) to attend a public reception in observance of National Community Action Month this Friday at 11:00 a.m. at NECAC headquarters.

Commissioners reviewed minutes from May 24, 2011. Com. Wilcox made a motion to approve these minutes, Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (3-0).

3:00 p.m. Commissioner received a call from a representative from Shafer, Kline & Warren, Inc. requesting additional information for the Traffic Engineering Assistance Program regarding the Kansas City Southern railroad bridge on CR 2580.

Coroner Gerald Luntsford arrived to discuss cell phone reception with this new county cell phone. Mr. Luntsford informed the Commission that he had talked to Laura Snelling, Chariton Valley, and she informed him that there wasn't a way to make the reception stronger. Mr. Luntsford agreed to terminate his land-line at the Coroner's office once satisfactory reception has been established.
