Thursday, June 9, 2016

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following
Present: John Truesdell, Presiding Commissioner; Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner, and
Ginger Tipton, Administrative Assistant.

9:00 a.m. Commissioner Truesdell called the meeting to order and moved to approve the agenda. On a motion duly made and seconded moved to approve the agenda. Motion approved. (2-0)

1:15p.m. Commissioners Crutchfield met with Mr. Murr to discuss an additional driveway permit and expects a permit from MoDot Tue. June 14th.

1:50 p.m. Minute's reviewed.

2:00 p.m. Will Ellis, arrived to discuss (a vendor license) for the 4th of July celebration. Statute 311483 was reviewed.

2:05 p.m. Craig Parsons, (Randolph County Health Department) came in to discuss Higbee and Cairo city sewer issues. Commissioners stated that city issues are not the responsibility of the county Commission.
Mike Rogers arrived to pick up a check for the 2011 T800 road tractor that was recently approved for purchased.

3:20 p.m. Richard Tregnago, (County Assessor) came in to set up an appointment for Tuesday, June 14th.


