

**RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION Minutes**  
**Tuesday March 29, 2016**

The Honorable Commission Convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: John Truesdell, Presiding Commissioner, Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner; Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner, Com. Truesdell would take notes in the absence of Cassie Cooley, as she is working on election setup for the clerk's office.

**9:00 a.m.** Commissioner Truesdell called the meeting to order and Commissioner Crutchfield moved for approval of the agenda, motion was seconded by Commissioner Wilcox, motion passed 3-0.  
The Commission discussed moving furniture in preparation for MVE (Missouri Vocational Enterprises) to take the furniture to refinish, Wed. 30<sup>th</sup> March 10:00.

**1:35 p.m.** La Deann and Randy Smith (Representatives from Sheriff's office) arrived to discuss labor laws and payroll issues at the Sheriff's office. The need to review the current 171 rule and ideas for payroll evaluation were discussed.

Mark Wapple, (Marathon Office Furniture) arrived and brought additional office furniture to demonstrate function and comfort. Preparation and introductions were made so that he could speak directly with representatives from the Circuit Judge's and Prosecutor's offices.

**2:20 p.m.** Skip Wilson (Poepping, Stone, & Bach (PSB), arrived to present draft engineering document and inspection findings for Bridge #0430035 and Bridge #2280071. Discussion centered for the summary of the PSB recommendations for these bridges, potential funding sources, and building techniques were presented.  
Gerald Lunsford, (County Coroner), arrived to discuss furniture and fixture options for the coroner's office in the new administration building.

**3:30 p.m.** Mary Jo Colley, (Public Administrator) arrived and gave a summary report for her office. Furniture and fixture options for the Public Administrator's office at the new administration building were discussed.


