

RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
Thursday, November 5, 2015

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: John Truesdell, Presiding Commissioner; Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner; Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner and Shelby Creed, Deputy Clerk.

8:00 a.m. The meeting was opened at the Justice Center. Com. Truesdell called the meeting to order. Com. Wilcox moved approval of the agenda. Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (3-0).

8:30 a.m. – The Commission met with Jeff Allen of Little Dixie Construction to review the brick, grout, and face stone for the new administration building. Commissioners selected cast stone, bricks, and mortar for the new administration building.

9:10 a.m. – Mark Nichols, (Sheriff) received Commissioners Truesdell and Wilcox to discuss the current video conference system, video RFP, and Security Lockup system RFP. Illegal trash dumping on CR2520 was turned over to the Sheriff for investigation.

9:45 a.m. - The Commission reconvened at the courthouse at 110 S. Main, Huntsville, MO.

10:00 a.m. - The Commission received Valinda Freed to discuss issues within the county.

10:30 a.m. - The Commission received two phone messages from county residents concerning gravel on roads. The issues were turned over to Mike Rogers, (Road and Bridge).

10:45 a.m. Mark Nichols, (Sheriff), arrived to discuss the issue on county road CR2520 and to report the problem is resolved. Sheriff Nichols discussed an additional hire of a deputy for Court Services.

10:40 a.m. Jim Charrier, (Randolph County EMD), arrived to discuss sending of invoices and to create a document for FEMMA with the County's letterhead. A program for county schools and law enforcement, to educate risk planning for School Bus shootings, is being offered for a \$200 cost. Jim Charrier will notify the Sheriff and county area schools.

Commissioners reviewed invoices for payment. Following review, Com. Wilcox moved to approve invoices as presented. Com. Crutchfield seconded, motion passed (3-0), and checks were signed.

Commissioners reviewed Erroneous Assessments. Following review, Com. Wilcox moved that the assessments be accepted as received. The motion was seconded by Com. Crutchfield and passed (3-0). Commissioners signed the following court orders in the matter of erroneous assessments: 2015-34; 2015-35; 2015-36; 2015-37; 2015-38; 2015-39 and 2015-40.

1:00 p.m. - The Military order of the Purple Heart arrived to report that the Randolph County was awarded Purple Heart County designation. A presentation of the award was made by Commander Paul E. Weeks, GYSgt Bryce Lockwood, and Commander John D. Dismer. Bob Riley, (Mayor of Moberly) and Connie Kissel, (Huntsville City Council Woman) were presented with awards from the OPH. Pictures of the presentation were taken.

2:00 p.m. - Skip Willison, (Senior Technician at Pepping, Stone, and Bach), was contacted by the Commission. Commissioners informed PSBA that they had been selected to complete a TEAP project request.


3:00 p.m. - Melanie Lindsey, (Deputy Clerk), arrived to present Blue Prints of the Justice Center.


Commissioners contacted Gerald Lundsford, (County Corner), to discuss office operations.
