

RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES

Tuesday, October 13, 2015

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: John Trussdell, Presiding Commissioner; Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner; Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner and Shelby Creed, Deputy Clerk.

9:00 a.m. Com. Trussdell called the meeting to order and moved approval of the agenda. Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (3-0). In the absence of Deputy Clerk Shelby Creed, Com. Trussdell will take minutes.

Com. Crutchfield reported there was no weekly Monday sub-contractors meeting this week due to Columbus Day.

Com. Crutchfield reported on a telephone call with John Krelick, Missouri Vocational Enterprises, to discuss courtroom fixtures.

Commissioners received a complaint from a county resident on County Road 2950 and County Road 2955.

Commissioners reviewed invoices for payment. Following review, Com. Wilcox moved to approve payments as presented. Com. Crutchfield seconded, motion passed (3-0), and checks were signed.

9:45 a.m. Com. Trussdell recessed the regular meeting so Commissioners could attend the bi-weekly meeting with the architect and contractors at the site of the new administration building.

10:15 a.m. Deputy Clerk Shelby Creed joined the regular meeting.

11:20 a.m. Commissioners returned to the Huntsville Courthouse and Com. Trussdell reconvened the regular meeting. (Chief Deputy Sheriff) Nevin Turner, Kathy Myers, (ALW Solutions, Inc), and Travis Tindall, (Nform Architecture) arrived to discuss requirements for an RFP of Security Systems at the new administration building.

Following the bi-weekly meeting at the Justice Center with the architects and contractors, Com. Wilcox moved to approve the purchase of a sidewalk connecting to the Circuit Clerk's office at the Justice Center in the amount of \$850---- for the new administration building project. Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (3-0).

1:00 p.m. Com. Trussdell recessed the regular meeting for lunch and a meeting with Gary Dewitt at the Justice Center.

2:20 p.m. Commissioners returned to the Huntsville Courthouse and Com. Trussdell reconvened the regular meeting.

Gary Dewitt, Flynn Drilling Company, arrived to discuss the recent meeting and inspection of the water pressure systems at the Justice Center with the Commission. Mr. Dewitt indicated he would advise restoration to the original pump at the Justice Center.

Commissioners returned a call to Road and Bridge Supervisor Mike Rogers to discuss the need to purchase CRS2P emulsion for sealing County Road 1660.

Commissioners handled correspondence.


