Thursday, October 29, 2015

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: John Truesdell, Presiding Commissioner; Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner; Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner and Shelby Creed, Deputy Clerk.

2:30 p.m. Com. Crutchfield returned the Huntsville Courthouse and joined the regular meeting.


3:00 p.m. Com. Wilcox left the regular meeting.
