

RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
Tuesday, October 6, 2015

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: John Truesdell, Presiding Commissioner; Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner; Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner and Shelby Creed, Deputy Clerk.

9:00 a.m. Com. Truesdell called the meeting to order. Com. Wilcox moved approval of the agenda. Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (3-0).

Tim Rice, InVia Pavement Technologies LLC, arrived to discuss hard surface roads in the county. Com. Crutchfield reported on his attendance at the weekly Monday sub-contractors meeting for the new administration building.

Treasurer Penny Henry arrived to discuss the October sales tax receipts. \$117,764.21 was received, for a year to date total of \$1,179,995.62. Also reported was \$29,137.73 received from use tax for a year to date total in 2015 of \$275,132.58. Receipts of the New Administrative Sales Tax are \$70,962.77 for a year to date total of \$526,211.04.

Randolph County Clerk, Will Ellis, arrived to report the fiber line was cut yesterday which operates the Sheriff's Radio System at the Justice Center. It is now fixed and working properly.

Randolph County Road and Bridge Supervisor, Mike Rogers, arrived to discuss a complaint from a county resident on County Road 1660 and other road Maintenance issues.

Commissioners signed a Road and Bridge Department, 'Contract for Work Done' document for the City of Higbee.

10:00 a.m. Randolph County Prosecuting Attorney Mike Fusselman arrived to discuss a smoke free ordinance for county grounds.

Commissioners reviewed invoices for payment. Following review, Com. Wilcox moved to approve payments as presented. Com. Crutchfield seconded, motion passed (3-0), and checks were signed.

Commissioners reviewed Erroneous Assessment Court Orders. Following review, Com. Wilcox moved that Erroneous Assessment Court Orders be signed. Com Crutchfield seconded, motion passed (3-0)

Randolph County Recorder of Deeds, Mark Price, arrived to discuss the Bradford System for the Recorder's Office at the New Administration Building.

Randolph County Assessor, Richard Tregnago, arrived to report on his attendance at the Assessor's annual conference and the progress of the Armeren UE lawsuit with the State Tax Commission.

Commissioners received a call from a county resident to discuss County Road 2220. They reported a water line was leaking and making it hard for buses to cross. For

incentive program document. Com. Crutchfield seconded, motion passed (3-0), and Com. Truesdell signed the document.

Com. Crutchfield contacted a county resident on County Road 2220 to report that the water line had been repaired.

Commissioners handled correspondence.


