

RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES

Thursday, October 8, 2015

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: John Truesdell, Presiding Commissioner, Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner, Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner and Shelby Creed, Deputy Clerk.

9:00 a.m. Com. Truesdell is participating in a radio interview in Moberly and will join the meeting later. In the absence of Com. Truesdell, Com. Wilcox will act as the Presiding Commissioner.

Com Wilcox called the meeting to order and moved approval of the agenda with one addition: The Commission has requested fuel bids and will open them at 11:00 a.m. Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (2-0).

Commissioners reviewed the monthly statements from Commerce Bank Trust for the refinanced Justice Center Lease Certificates.

Road and Bridge Supervisor Mike Rogers arrived to discuss road maintenance issues. Also discussed was the new road into the Administration Building parking lot and County Road 1660.

10:30 a.m. Com. Truesdell joined the regular meeting and reported on his radio interview this morning with the newly hired Emergency Management Director Jim Charrier and the current Emergency Management Director/Moberly Fire Chief, (Robert Creed).

Commissioners contacted County Clerk Will Ellis to discuss statements from Commerce Bank and Trust.

Commissioners reviewed invoices for payment. Following review, Com. Wilcox moved to approve payments as presented. Com. Crutchfield seconded, motion passed (3-0), and checks were signed.

11:00 a.m. Commissioners received the following fuel bids for the month of January, February and March 2016: MFA Oil-\$2.1460 per gallon, Wright's Oil-\$1.94 per gallon and Brownfield Oil-\$1.899 per gallon. Following review, Com. Crutchfield moved to approve the bid from Brownfield Oil at \$1.899 per gallon. Com. Wilcox seconded and motion passed (3-0).

Commissioners contacted Road and Bridge Supervisor Mike Rogers to discuss the fuel bid selected for the month of January, February and March 2016.

Com. Truesdell reported on his attendance Tuesday at the Moberly Area Chamber of Commerce, 'After Hours Open House', featuring Comfort Inn of Moberly and the new owner, 'Jay Patel'.

1:30 p.m. Com. Truesdell recessed the regular meeting so Com. Wilcox and Com. Crutchfield could inspect the site of the county administration building. Com. Truesdell and Deputy Clerk Shelby Creed left to attend the 911 Joint Communication Users Committee meeting in the EOC at the Moberly Police Department at 2:00.
