

RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES

Tuesday, November 3, 2011

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: Susan Carter, Presiding Commissioner; Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner; Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner; and Shelby Creed, Deputy Clerk.

9:00 a.m. Com. Carter called the meeting to order and moved approval of the agenda with one addition, Chief Deputy Nevin Turner will be arriving at 2:30 p.m. for review and signature on the Sheriff's Supplemental Fund Application. Com. Wilcox seconded and motion passed (3-0).

Melissa Quesenberry, City Directory Inc., arrived to take orders for the City of Moberly Directory. The Commission will not be purchasing one.

Under correspondence Commissioners received an invitation from the County 4-H Extension office for the Youth 4-H Banquet Saturday, November 5, at 6:00 p.m. Com. Crutchfield will be attending the banquet.

County Clerk Will Ellis arrived to report the Ward brothers completed their annual rental payments for use of the county farm.

11:30 a.m. Road and Bridge Supervisor Mike Rogers arrived to report on repair estimates for the 2004 John Deere grader. Also discussed was using road and bridge employees to repair the vandalized fence at the Justice Center. Mr. Rogers indicated the repairs to the dump truck that was in an accident at NAPCO are almost completed. Commissioners reviewed invoices for payment. Following review, Com. Wilcox made a motion to approve payments as presented with the exception of # 6823 to Eskew Mechanical; this check will be held until the repair to the Huntsville boiler is completed. Com. Crutchfield seconded, motion passed (3-0), and checks were signed.

1:00 p.m. Com. Crutchfield received a call from Dan Shepard, CR 2010, who requested rock on his gravel road. Com. Crutchfield will pass this information along to Road and Bridge Supervisor Mike Rogers.

Com. Carter contacted Ron Watts, MoDOT, to discuss accessing BRO funds for the CR 2580 KCS Railroad Bridge Replacement Project.


Commissioners and County Clerk Will Ellis reviewed the lease/purchase contract with City Bank for the Circuit Clerk's storage unit.


Laura Snelling, Chariton Valley, arrived to discuss the auto attendant on the new county phone system.

4:00 p.m. Meeting was adjourned.


