

RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES

Thursday, December 22, 2011

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: Susan Carter, Presiding Commissioner; Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner; Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner; and Shelby Creed, Deputy Clerk.

9:00 a.m. Com. Carter called the meeting to order and moved approval of the agenda. Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (3-0).

Com. Carter received a call from Michael Purol, Poepping, Stone, Bach & Associates, to update the Commission on the CR 2660 BRO bridge project.

Com. Carter contacted Ted Sander, Chairman of the Moberly Special Road District, concerning the progress on the CR 1330 bridge replacement project. Mr. Sander reported construction of the bridge was completed but Special Road District's in-kind dirt work has not been completed due to inclement weather.

10:15 a.m. Road and Bridge Supervisor Mike Rogers arrived to discuss road maintenance issues. Also discussed were the CR 1330 bridge and the possibility of the county helping the Special Road District.

Darryl Hansen stopped in to wish Commissioners a Merry Christmas and to pass along compliments to the Road and Bridge crew.

10:30 a.m. Com. Carter recessed the regular meeting so Commissioners and Road and Bridge Supervisor Mike Rogers, could inspect CR 2220 by Hagar's Cemetery to determine if a guardrail was needed. It was determined that warning signs could be installed immediately on the approaching curves as the guardrail request is debated.

11:00 a.m. Commissioners returned to Huntsville and Com. Carter reconvened the regular meeting. Com. Carter returned a call to Tom Fuhrman, Randolph County Extension. Mr. Fuhrman requested a meeting with Commissioners to make 2012 budget requests. Com. Crutchfield contacted Craig White, President of the Hagar's Cemetery Association, to inform him the county will be installing warning signs on CR 2220. Com. Wilcox contacted NAPCO asking when the county will be able to purchase 1 1/4" clean rock.

12:00 p.m. Com. Carter recessed the regular meeting for lunch.

1:00 p.m. Com. Carter reconvened the regular meeting.





4:00 p.m. Meeting was adjourned.




