Tuesday, December 6, 2011

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: Susan Carter, Presiding Commissioner; Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner; and Shelby Creed, Deputy Clerk. Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner was attending the 54th Annual Asphalt Conference in Rolla, Missouri.

9:00 a.m. Com. Carter called the meeting to order and moved approval of the agenda. Com. Wilcox seconded and motion passed (2-0).

County Collector Shiela Miller arrived to discuss implementation of the NACO discount drug card within Randolph County.
