

RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES

Tuesday, January 10, 2012

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: Susan Carter, Presiding Commissioner; Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner; Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner; and Shelby Creed, Deputy Clerk.

9:00 a.m. Com. Carter called the meeting to order and moved approval of the agenda. Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (3-0).

Road and Bridge Supervisor Mike Rogers arrived to report an accident that occurred yesterday in which a road grader over turned and the operator had to seek medical treatment.

Com. Wilcox contacted Dave Gass, ALTORFER, to discuss repairs needed to the Caterpillar road grader that was damaged.

Com. Carter received a call from Gary Strack, SKW, to discuss the grant application for the CR 2580 Bridge Replacement Project.

County Clerk Will Ellis arrived to review the 2012 budget.

10:00 a.m. Com. Carter recessed the regular meeting and convened the first public hearing for comments on the 2012 budget. In attendance were: Ben Herrold, Moberly Monitor Index; County Assessor Richard Tregnago; and Chief Budget Officer Will Ellis.

10:30 a.m. Com. Carter adjourned the public hearing and reconvened the regular meeting.

Dave Gass, ALTORFER, arrived to discuss the repairs needed to the Caterpillar road grader that was damaged.

11:00 a.m. Com. Crutchfield entered the first reading of the petition to close portions of CR 2561 into the record. Com. Crutchfield asked for any questions or comments. No members of the public were present to comment. Com. Crutchfield noted that as required by Section 228.110 R.S.Mo. (1990) the petition was dually posted in the following locations: City Hall of Higbee, MO; VFW in Higbee, MO; Higbee Senior Center, and on the barricades of CR 2561 on December 8, 2011. Com. Crutchfield indicated the second and final reading of the petition will be April 3, 2012 when Commissioners will take action on the petition.

The Road and Bridge Employee involved in the grader accident stopped in to visit with Commissioners about the incident.

Com. Crutchfield reported that he stopped by the Circuit Clerk's Storage Unit construction site to inspect the additions to the footings needed as a substructure to the building.

Commissioners reviewed minutes from January 5, 2012. Following review, Com. Wilcox made a motion to approve these minutes. Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (3-0).

Commissioners signed official minutes from December 29, 2011 and January 3, 2012.

1:00 p.m. Sheriff Mark Nichols and Chief Deputy Nevin Turner arrived for the 2012 budget review. Chief Deputy Turner reported that certain computers were damaged by a step-down transformer failure.
