

RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES

Tuesday, February 14, 2012

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: Susan Carter, Presiding Commissioner; Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner; Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner; and Shelby Creed, Deputy Clerk.

9:00 a.m. Com. Carter called the meeting to order and moved approval of the agenda. Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (3-0).

911 Coordinator Joan Joseph arrived to discuss the low number of county maps left in the County Clerk's office. Mrs. Joseph reported that Crown Press should be giving her a quote soon for the new maps to be purchased next year. Com. Carter received a call from Circuit Clerk Peggy Boots reporting that the Moberly Courthouse parking lot had not been cleaned of snow today. Com. Carter indicated she would contact Rick Howard, Maintenance, to discuss the issue.

10:35 a.m. Rick Howard, Maintenance, arrived to report the Moberly parking lot had not been cleaned due to a hydraulic leak on the bobcat. Also discussed was purchasing a snow blade for the maintenance truck; the warranty repair on the windows needed for the Justice Center; and the recreation fence at the Justice Center. Mr. Howard also reported that the hot water recirculation pump was out and a new one had been ordered for the bathrooms in the Judge's and Circuit Clerk's office at the Justice Center.

Com. Crutchfield contacted Gary Griffin, Pozzi Windows, to discuss the warranty on the windows at the Justice Center.

11:30 a.m. Ted Phelan, Sales Consultant at Woody's Municipal Supply Co., stopped in to discuss possible purchase of a boom mower. Road and Bridge Supervisor Mike Rogers was contacted to discuss the possibility of scheduling a demo a little later in the year.

Commissioners reviewed minutes from January 31, 2012; February 7, 2012; and February 9, 2012. Following review, Com. Wilcox made a motion to approve these minutes. Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (3-0).

1:20 p.m. Road and Bridge Supervisor Mike Rogers arrived to discuss road maintenance issues. Also discussed was the cross over access from Highway 63 to CR 1635 north of the propane distribution station.

Commissioners approved contract for work done for City of Higbee.

Public Administrator Martha Creed stopped in to say hello.

1:45 p.m. Com. Carter recessed the regular meeting. Commissioners left with Road and Bridge Supervisor Mike Rogers to inspect the CR 1227 right-of-ways. Mr. Rogers also inspected a reported stopped up culvert on the road which will need cleaning.

2:30 p.m. Commissioners returned to Huntsville and Com. Carter reconvened the regular meeting.

Commissioners reviewed invoices for payment. Following review, Com. Crutchfield made a motion to approve invoices as presented. Com. Wilcox seconded, motion passed (3-0), and checks were signed.

Com. Wilcox contacted Sherry Russell, Rural Cairo, following her letter to Missouri Department of Transportation Director Kevin Keith regarding CR 1635 having a second access to Highway 63. Com. Wilcox was informed her a meeting was being planned by Brian Haeffner, MODOT, and the Cairo City Council, which the Randolph County Commission will be invited to attend.

Com. Wilcox contacted Sheriff Mark Nichols to inquire about the reemployment rights for veterans. Also discussed was the fence construction in the exercise area at the jail.

Commissioners handled correspondence.

4:00 p.m. Meeting was adjourned.


