

RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES

Tuesday, February 7, 2012

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: Susan Carter, Presiding Commissioner; Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner; and Shelby Creed, Deputy Clerk. Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner was absent due to a family illness.

9:00 a.m. Com. Carter called the meeting to order and moved approval of the agenda Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (2-0).

Commissioners reported on their attendance at their annual training session in Jefferson City last week. Also they presented their Certificates of Training completion to the County Clerk.

Com. Carter received a call from Emergency Management Director Robert Creed to discuss the Emergency Management Performance grant.



County Assessor Richard Tregnago arrived to discuss the ongoing personal property assessment appeal with a county resident.


Commissioners handled correspondence.


