

RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES

Thursday, March 8, 2012

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: Susan Carter, Presiding Commissioner; Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner; Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner; and Shelby Creed, Deputy Clerk.

9:00 a.m. Com. Carter called the meeting to order and moved approval of the agenda with one correction: Commissioners will be meeting with Gary Bush, City of Moberly, at 2:00 p.m. Thursday. Com. Wilcox seconded and motion passed (3-0).

Com. Wilcox and Com. Crutchfield reported on their groundbreaking ceremony for the Moberly Senior High School renovation project on Wednesday afternoon at 3:30.

Septagon Construction representatives arrived for the weekly progress meeting for the Circuit Clerk's storage unit. They believe completion will be before the targeted date of April 15th.

Com. Carter reported on her attendance last night at the Region G Solid Waste Board meeting and the Mark Twain Region Council of Governments meeting in Perry, MO.

Com. Crutchfield reported on a conversation with a county resident requesting gravel on CR 1010. This information was forwarded to Road and Bridge Supervisor Mike Rogers.

Commissioners received notification from FEMA that Disaster Declaration 1961 was officially closed out.

Commissioners reviewed invoices for payment. Following review, Com. Crutchfield made a motion to approve payments as presented. Com. Wilcox seconded, motion passed (3-0), and checks were signed.

Commissioners signed official minutes from February 28, 2012 and March 1, 2012.

Commissioners contacted Senator McCaskill's office in Washington asking for support for the Kasey-Blunt Amendment to continue funding for the BRO program.

4:00 p.m. Meeting was adjourned.


