

RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES

Thursday, May 17, 2012

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: Susan Carter, Presiding Commissioner; Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner; Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner; and Shelby Creed, Deputy Clerk.

9:00 a.m. Com. Carter called the meeting to order and moved approval of the agenda with one addition: Laura Snelling, Chariton Valley, will be in at 10:30 to discuss internet service at the Justice Center. Com. Wilcox seconded and motion passed (3-0).

Com. Carter and Com. Crutchfield reported on their attendance Wednesday, May 16, at the NECAC ceremony celebrating National Community Action Month.

Commissioners received documents by email from Associated Electric defining the county's right-of-way on CR 1227.

Commissioners signed official minutes from May 1, 2012 and May 3, 2012.

Commissioners reviewed invoices for payment. Following review, Com. Wilcox made a motion to approve payments as presented. Com. Crutchfield seconded, motion passed (3-0), and checks were signed.

10:30 a.m. Laura Snelling, Chariton Valley, and County Clerk Will Ellis arrived to discuss the internet on the Sheriff's side of the Justice Center and at the Road and Bridge Department. Also discussed was the new partnership between Chariton Valley and Verizon.

11:15 a.m. Road and Bridge Supervisor Mike Rogers arrived to discuss road maintenance issues. Also discussed were the number of roads and the mileage of the roads maintained by the county for submittal to MODOT to increase the county's qualification for CART funds.

Com. Carter left a message with Anthony Taylor concerning the CR 1395/S. Landrum drainage project and a culvert to be installed on his property.

Treasurer Penny Henry arrived to discuss an old account that she believed needed to be closed. The account number is 0391537154. Treasurer Penny Henry also requested Com. Carter's co-signature on payments for engineering services for the CR 2660 BRO project.

12:30 p.m. Com. Carter received a call from Circuit Clerk Peggy Boots to discuss scheduling for the moving of records and shelves to the new Circuit Clerk's storage unit. Com. Carter then contacted Road and Bridge Supervisor Mike Rogers to discuss the moving date.

Rick Howard, Maintenance, arrived to discuss maintenance issues. Also discussed was the painting of the new replacement windows at the Justice Center. Mr. Howard reported that the new air conditioning unit is installed at the Huntsville Courthouse.

Commissioners reviewed minutes from May 10, 2012. Following review, Com. Wilcox made a motion to approve these minutes. Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (3-0).

2:00 p.m. County Recorder Mark Price arrived to report that a client in the Records Office complained about an injury that occurred when she stubbed her toe on a protruding screw. It has since been repaired.

Commissioners reviewed minutes from May 15, 2012. Following review, Com. Crutchfield made a motion to approve these minutes. Com. Wilcox seconded and motion passed (3-0).

Com. Crutchfield received a call from Road and Bridge Supervisor Mike Rogers to confirm Monday, May 21, as the date to move for the Circuit Clerk's records and shelving from the basement of the Moberly Courthouse to the new Circuit Clerk's storage unit.

2:30 p.m. County Clerk Will Ellis and Road and Bridge Supervisor Mike Rogers arrived to assist the Commission in answering written questions from Enbridge Pipeline relating to the upcoming pipeline construction in Randolph County.


3:00 p.m. Gary Million, Tri-State, stopped in to discuss future road equipment needs and equipment leasing for the county.

4:00 p.m. Meeting was adjourned.


