

RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
Thursday, June 21, 2012

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: Susan Carter, Presiding Commissioner; Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner, Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner; and Shelby Creed, Deputy Clerk.

9:00 a.m. Com. Carter called the meeting to order and moved approval of the agenda with two additions: Commissioners will be approving the Hazard Mitigation Plan renewal and the Commission will be approving the Moberly Corrections Center/Assessor's office Memorandum of Understanding for the use of the GIS. Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (3-0).

Com. Carter received a call from Debbie Miller, Executive Director of the Moberly Area Chamber of Commerce, to discuss setting up an informational meeting with the Chamber and others to discuss placing a local use tax measure on the November ballot.

Commissioners handled correspondence.

Com. Carter received a call from Gary Strack, SKW, with questions about the Enbridge Pipeline coming through the county.

10:00 a.m. Milli Broekelmann, Cintas Corporation, arrived to discuss a contract proposal with the county for uniforms and cleaning products.

Commissioners reviewed invoices for payment. Following review, Com. Wilcox made a motion to approve invoices as presented. Com. Crutchfield seconded, motion passed (3-0), and checks were signed.

Commissioners received acknowledgement from the Department of Energy in response to a letter of support on behalf of Westinghouse Company concerning development of domestic small nuclear reactor technologies.

Commissioners reviewed a Memorandum of Understanding between the Moberly Corrections Center and the Assessor's office concerning use of the county GIS database. Following review, Com. Crutchfield made a motion authorizing Com. Carter's signature on the document. Com. Wilcox seconded, motion passed (3-0), and memorandum was signed.

Commissioners received a call from District 22 State Representative Randy Asbury to discuss the possibility of placing a local use tax measure on the November ballot.

Commissioners reviewed the Hazard Mitigation Consultant renewable contract for Randolph County. Following review, Com. Wilcox made a motion to authorize Com. Carter's signature on the contract. Com. Crutchfield seconded, motion passed (3-0), and contract was signed.



4:00 p.m. Meeting was adjourned.


