

RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES

Tuesday, October 30, 2012

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: Susan Carter, Presiding Commissioner; Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner; Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner; and Shelby Creed, Deputy Clerk.

9:00 a.m. Com. Carter called the meeting to order and moved approval of the agenda with one addition: Prosecuting Attorney Mike Fusselman will arrive at 2:30 p.m. to discuss staffing needs. Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (3-0).

Sheriff Mark Nichols stopped in to review weekend law enforcement activities. Road and Bridge Supervisor Mike Rogers stopped in to review equipment needs and upcoming fuel purchases.

Commissioners noted receipt of a certificate from the Department of Natural Resources, State Historic Preservation Office concerning the Moberly Commercial Historic District.

Commissioners contacted Brownfield Oil, MFA Oil and Wright's Oil to request bids for 2500 gallons of diesel fuel to be submitted by 2:00 p.m. today.

Rick Howard, Maintenance, arrived to discuss sewer smells at the Huntsville Courthouse and Justice Center. Discussed was the lack of response for the request of bids to improve the drainage in the exercise area at the Justice Center. During heavy rains, water runs inside the jail from the exercise area and a sewer cleanout is opened for that excess water to drain from the jail. This causes the sewer odor to move throughout the building. Assessor Richard Tregnago stopped in to discuss a reported lawsuit involving Moberly resident Jerry Swartz and the Assessor's office.

Commissioners approved and signed payroll checks.

Carol Browning, Community Kitchen Inc. Moberly, arrived to discuss advertising the upcoming openings on the board of directors.

County Clerk Will Ellis reported that AT&T arrived at the Public Administrator's office Friday, October 26, to hook up the internet services. Clerk Ellis also reported speaking to Brandon Lucas, Fusion Technology, who will set up e-mail addresses for the Public Administrator and her assistant.

2:00 p.m. The following bids were received for fuel for the Road and Bridge Department: Brownfield-\$3.235; MFA-\$3.341; Wright's-\$3.296. Following discussion, Com. Crutchfield moved to accept the bid from Brownfield Oil to be delivered tomorrow. Com. Wilcox seconded and motion passed (3-0).

Dave Gass, Altorfer, stopped in to discuss future road and bridge equipment needs.

Commissioners signed official minutes from October 11, 2012; October 16, 2012; October 18, 2012; and October 23, 2012.

2:30 p.m. Prosecuting Attorney Mike Fusselman arrived to discuss future staffing needs in his office.

Commissioners reviewed payroll expenses. Following review, Com. Crutchfield made a motion to approve payments as presented. Com. Wilcox seconded, motion passed (3-0), and checks were signed.

Commissioners reviewed minutes from October 25, 2012. Following review, Com. Wilcox made a motion to approve these minutes. Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (3-0).

Commissioners handled correspondence.


