

RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
Thursday, November 15, 2012

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: Susan Carter, Presiding Commissioner; Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner; Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner; and Shelby Creed, Deputy Clerk.

9:00 a.m. Com. Carter called the meeting to order and moved approval of the agenda. Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (3-0).

Com. Carter contacted Cairo Mayor Jerry Frans to discuss the need of a Sheriff's Deputy in Cairo for demolition of a condemned house.

Commissioners reviewed invoices for payment. Following review, Com. Wilcox made a motion to approve invoices as presented. Com. Crutchfield seconded, motion passed (3-0), and checks were signed.

Commissioners received a call from Lynda Davis, Prosecuting Attorney's Office, to discuss the PA's liability insurance policy and if coverage could be provided instead through MOPERM. Following investigation, Commissioner concluded it could not be.


2:00 p.m. Sam Richardson stopped in to say hello to the Commission and discussed his participation in the recent Randolph County Health Department Strategic Planning session.

Commissioners signed and updated signature cards for accounts connected with the Public Administrator's Office.


Commissioners handled correspondence.
