

**RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES**  
**Thursday, July 10, 2014**

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: Susan Carter, Presiding Commissioner; Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner; Brock Nagel, Deputy Clerk.

**9:00 a.m.** Com. Carter called the meeting to order and moved approval of the agenda. Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (2-0). Com. Carter noted a change in the agenda that the 911 Joint Communications Quarterly Meeting will be postponed to July 17, 2014.

Commissioners received a call from Jennifer Wilson, N-Form Architecture with an estimate on the new administrative building with geothermal and expanded floor plan included in the estimate.

Interim Road and Bridge Supervisor Dale Herron arrived to report that the guard rail on CR 2755 had been hit by someone and will be repaired.

Dave Rasmussen arrived to discuss the new administrative building.

County Clerk Will Ellis arrived to report that Randolph County Health Inspector Janet Murray would be inspecting the food area at the Justice Center and that Ameren requested an appointment with the Board of Equalization on July 24, 2014.

Commissioners received a call from Ron Watts, MoDot who reported that unless Congress acts and restores funding to the Federal Highway Trust Fund, funding for BRO projects across the country could be in jeopardy. Counties will be receiving correspondence on the issue soon.

Commissioners reviewed minutes from July 3, 2014. Following review, Com. Carter made a motion to approve these minutes. Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (2-0).

Commissioners reviewed invoices for payment. Following review, Com. Crutchfield made a motion to approve payments as presented. Com. Carter seconded, motion passed (2-0), and checks were signed.

**12:30 p.m.** County Clerk Will Ellis arrived to deliver Randolph County Health Inspector Janet Murray's final report following her inspection of the food prep area at the Justice Center. She noted several items needing attention which will be passed on to Consolidated Food Service.

Commissioners signed and approved work done for the City of Cairo hauling 17.8 tons of rock at \$4.00 per ton.

**3:30 p. m.** Commissioners contacted the offices of Representative Vicky Hartzler, Senator Roy Blunt, and Senator Claire McCaskill to express concerns on the lack of funding for the Highway Trust Fund.

Following review of the only bid received Com. Crutchfield made motion to accept Michael Walker's bid in the amount of \$3850.00 to construct a fence along the property recently donated to the county. Com. Carter seconded the motion. Motion passed (2-0).
