

RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
Thursday, September 11, 2014

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: Susan Carter, Presiding Commissioner; Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner; Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner and Brock Nagel, Deputy Clerk.

9:00 a.m. Com. Carter called the meeting to order and moved approval of the agenda. Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (3-0).

Interim Road and Bridge Supervisor Dale Herron arrived to discuss road maintenance issues. Also discussed was the need for an additional culvert on the east end of CR1660.

Com. Crutchfield contacted Michael Puro1, PSB&A to discuss replacing a fence for a property owner on CR2660 following completion of the bridge.

Commissioners reviewed invoices for payment. Following review, Com. Crutchfield made a motion to approve the payments as presented. Com. Wilcox seconded, motion passed (3-0), and checks were signed.

Commissioners reviewed election expenses associated with the Amendment 1 recount. Following review, Com. Crutchfield made a motion to approve these expenses. Com. Wilcox seconded, motion passed (3-0), and checks were signed.

A county resident called inquiring about the size of gravel being placed on CR1355/1356. He was informed the quarry had been loading a different size of gravel which the county has ceased using. The Commissioners have an appointment at the quarry today to investigate the change in the sizing of the gravel.

County Clerk Will Ellis arrived to present building and equipment inventories for review and approval to be submitted to county insurance companies.

Com. Wilcox contacted the Macon County Commission to discuss the quality of rock coming from the quarry both counties use.

11:30p.m. Com. Carter recessed the meeting so Commissioners could attend the Old Settlers luncheon at Trask Hall.

12:50p.m. Com. Carter reconvened the regular meeting.

2:45p.m. Recorder Mark Price arrived to inform the Commission of a recent request for records he received.

Commissioners were asked to write a letter supporting a grant request for Randolph County Sheltered Industries.


