

**RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES**  
**Tuesday, September 16, 2014**

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: Susan Carter, Presiding Commissioner, Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner, Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner and Brock Nagel, Deputy Clerk.

**9:00 a.m.** Com. Carter called the meeting to order and moved approval of the agenda with one addition. Commissioners will review fuel bids for January through April. Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (3-0).

Rick Howard, Maintenance, arrived to discuss maintenance issues. He reported that both courthouse boilers were started without a problem.

Interim Road and Bridge Supervisor Dale Herron arrived to discuss maintenance issues as well as recent issue with gravel sizing and progress on the BRO-BO88 CR 2580 (22) bridge replacement project.

**11:00a.m.** John Muehe, Mayor of Renick, arrived to discuss the updates to the sewer system for the city of Renick. Fuel bids were received from Brownfield and MFA Oil for a January-April contract. Following review Com. Wilcox made a motion to reject both bids as presented. Com. Crutchfield seconded, and motion passed (3-0).




**3:00p.m.** Commissioner's began review of the county's insured property schedule.


**4:00p.m.** Meeting was adjourned.
