

RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
Tuesday, September 2, 2014

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: Susan Carter, Presiding Commissioner; Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner; Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner and Brock Nagel, Deputy Clerk.

9:00 a.m. Com. Carter called the meeting to order and moved approval of the agenda. Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (3-0).

Rick Howard, Maintenance, arrived to discuss maintenance issues.

Commissioners received notice from Missouri Department of Agriculture that the Remonumentation Program would be in effect again next year. The Commission will review and make a decision at a later date if the county will participate.

Commissioners reviewed invoices for payment. Following review, Com. Wilcox made a motion to approve the payments as presented. Com. Crutchfield seconded, motion passed (3-0), and checks were signed.

10:25a.m. In other correspondence, Commissioners received notice from the Army Corps of Engineers that a structure on CR 2270 over Sweet Springs Creek was non-compliant. As the road is in the Moberly Special Road District the information will be shared with that Commission.

Commissioners reviewed payroll expenses. Following review, Com. Wilcox made a motion to approve payroll expenses as presented. Com. Crutchfield seconded, motion passed (3-0), and checks were signed.

Com. Crutchfield returned a call to a resident who was concerned after hearing large explosions in the southeast corner of the county. The resident was informed that the Sheriff's Department was investigating vandalism in that area.

Bennie Bradley, Moberly Special Road District, contacted the Commission to discuss the non-compliant notice received from the Army Corps of Engineers. The Commission will forward the non-compliant notice to the Moberly Special Road District.

Commissioners received a call from Travis Tindall, nForm Architecture, to schedule a meeting next week to review plans for the administrative building.

Commissioners reviewed the minutes from August 26, 2014 and August 28, 2014. Following review, Com. Crutchfield made a motion to approve these minutes. Com. Wilcox seconded, and motion passed (3-0).

Commissioners contacted two land surveyors to solicit bids for continuation of the county's Remonumentation Program.

Chairman Paul Haque, Moberly Special Road District, contacted the Commission to discuss road closure and culvert replacement policies. Also discussed was the non-compliance notice.

1:30p.m. 911 Coordinator Justin Roberts arrived to discuss updates to County's Road and Bridge Policy's.

Tim Jeffries, Secretary of Moberly Special Road District, arrived to pick up a copy of the non-compliant notice received from the Army Corps of Engineers.

County Collector Shiela Miller arrived to present court orders restoring two parcels to the county tax rolls. Following discussion, Com. Wilcox made a motion to approve rescinding the third sale offerings for parcel 07-7.0-360-3.0-000-098.000 and 10-1.0-010-2.0-003-090.000. Com. Crutchfield seconded the motion, and passed (3-0).

Ron Warts, MoDot, contacted the Commission to discuss additional engineering needed by the contractor for the BRO-BO88 CR 2580(22) bridge replacement project.
