

RANDOLPH COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
Thursday, September 17, 2015

The Honorable Commission convened at the Huntsville Courthouse with the following present: John Truesdell, Presiding Commissioner; Wayne Wilcox, Eastern District Commissioner; Jerry Crutchfield, Western District Commissioner and Shelby Creed, Deputy Clerk.

9:00 a.m. Com. Truesdell called the meeting to order and moved approval of the agenda. Com. Crutchfield seconded and motion passed (3-0).

County Clerk Will Ellis arrived to discuss state statute RSMO 58.095 dealing with the multiple fatality accidents.

Treasurer Penny Henry arrived to present Exhibit D payment number five to Little Dixie Construction. Commissioners will review the invoice. For \$191,528.89.
